#### 1. ROK Responded to CJK Working Set 2021 V3.0

ROK responded to the Consolidated Comments of CJK Working Set 2021 V3.0 (IRG N2549) on the IRG ORT (Online Review Tool).

#### 2. Changing glyph and/or IDS of 97 KR Hanja chars containing '吐 (U+53F1)'

In many UCS Hanja chars such as 岱(U+358C), 唟(U+551F), 唟(U+359C), and 莻 (U+848A) containing '叱(U+53F1)' as a component, '叱(U+53F1)' is used for special purposes to indicate a syllable-final sound 's/t' or to change lax sound to fortis sound in Middle Korean.

The reason why ' $\mathbb{H}(U+53F1)$ ' is used for such purposes is that the reading of ' $\mathbb{H}$ ' is derived from the reading of ' $\mathbb{H}$  [ $q\bar{\imath}$ ]'.

There are 97 such Hanja chars containing 'It(U+53F1)' used for special purposes. Currently glyphs and/or IDSs of these 97 Hanja chars are in the form of '□+te' (mouse + dagger), which are different from the real usage in Korean.

Therefore, KR suggests to change glyphs and/or IDSs of the 97 Hanja chars from '□+∠' (mouse + dagger) to '□+∠' (mouse + seven). This issue is well documented in IRG N2549\_KR\_Resp1c\_Chg\_glyph\_IDS\_₧(U+53F1).

# **3. Feedback to IRG N2551 Restriction on encoding of modern self-created characters** ROK reviewed IRG N2551 and submitted a feedback.

## 4. Updated ROK Normalization Rule V1.6.

ROK is in the process of updating ROK Normalization Rule V1.5. and plan to release V1.6 (IRG N2573) after IRG #59. The aim of this document is to set up normalization rules for Hanja characters.

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
